GENERAL

- 1. THE TERM "CONTRACTOR" IN THIS SET OF DRAWINGS & SPECIFICATIONS REFERS TO THE "NOMINATED SUB CONTRACTOR (NSC)".
- 2. ALL DIMENSIONS SHOWN ARE IN MILLIMETERS (MM). USE FIGURED DIMENSIONS. DO NOT SCALE DRAWINGS.
- 3. FFL INDICATES FINISHED FLOOR LEVEL & CH INDICATES PROPOSED FALSE CEILING LEVEL.
- 4. ALL DIMENSIONS SHALL BE VERIFIED ON SITE BEFORE COMMENCEMENT OF WORK. ANY DISCREPANCIES SHALL BE MADE KNOWN TO THE S.O. FOR DECISION BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH THE WORK.
- 5. ALL MATERIALS & FINISHES SHALL READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE SPECIFICATIONS AND DETAILED DRAWINGS.

SHOP DRAWINGS MUST SHOW ALL VISIBLE BLOCKING.
- 8. ALL CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIALS USED SHALL COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF APPLICABLE CODES, STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL APPLY THE DESIGN INTENT AS ESTABLISHED IN THE DOCUMENTS TO ALL CIRCUMSTANCES AND CONDITIONS TO ENSURE DESIGN CONSISTENCY THROUGHOUT.

THE WORK OF ALL DISCIPLINES SHALL BE CAREFULLY COORDINATED WITH THE OVERALL AESTHETIC APPEARANCE OF THE BUILDING. DISCREPANCIES ARE TO BE IMMEDIATELY BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE S.O.
- 12. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT AREAS WITH NEW MATERIALS & FINISHES FROM DAMAGE HOWSOEVER CAUSED DURING THE PERIOD OF CONSTRUCTION. ANY SUCH DAMAGE ARISING SHALL BE REPAIRED OR REPLACED TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE S.O.
- 13. CONTRACTOR IS TO REINSTATE EXISTING AREAS/ ITEMS DAMAGED BY CONTRACTOR'S WORKS AT THEIR OWN COST.
- 14. WALL FASTENERS AND FASTENING DEVICES ARE TO BE CONCEALED. DISSIMILAR METALS USED SHALL BE PROPERLY ISOLATED FROM CONTACT TO PREVENT ELECTROLYTIC ACTION LEADING TO CORROSION.
- 15. ALL ACCESS PANELS REQUIRED BY M&E SHALL BE UNOBTRUSIVE AND CONCEALED WHERE POSSIBLE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT SHOP DRAWING FOR APPROVAL BEFORE SUCH WORKS.
- 16. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE AND MAKE PROVISIONS FOR ANY OPENINGS DEEMED REQUIRED FOR WALL, FLOOR AND CEILING BY ANY SUBCONTRACTOR FOR FIXINGS AND INSTALLATION OF ANY EQUIPMENT, ACCESSORIES AND FIXTURES. SUCH OPENINGS SHALL BE MADE GOOD AND SEALED WITH SEALANT AFTERWARDS.
- 17. ALL FIRE-SAFETY RELATED WORKS SHALL BE COMPLETED WITH RELEVANT SIGNAGE BEFORE FSSD REGISTERED INSPECTOR'S TOP INSPECTION.

- 3. REFLECTED CEILING PLANS TO BE COORDINATED WITH RESPECTIVE ACMV & ELECTRICAL SUB CONTRACTORS SHOP DRAWINGS.

LIGHTING FIXTURES

- 1. DECORATIVE LIGHTING SPECIFICATION IS TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH REFLECTED CEILING PLANS. QUANTITIES INDICATED MAY VARY. CONTRACTOR IS TO PRICE EACH LIGHT FITTING TYPE SEPARATELY IN THE SCHEDULE.
- 2. CONTRACTOR IS TO SUPPLY & INSTALL ALL DECORATIVE LIGHT FITTINGS, LIGHT FIXTURES IN FITMENTS, LIGHTING CABLES, ROUTING, LIGHTING POINTS & DIMMER/SWITCHES.
- 3. L.E.D. TYPE COVE LIGHTING SHALL BE PROVIDED FOR CURVED FITMENTS AS INDICATED. COVE LIGHTING IS TO BE CONTINUOUS AND WITHOUT DARK SPOTS.
