SECTION 2 : COORDINATING SIZES FOR DOORSETS

2.1 Scope

This Section specifies the coordinating sizes for doorsets of all material to be used in buildings, and which will fill coordinating spaces in dimensionally coordinated buildings.

2.2 Specifications

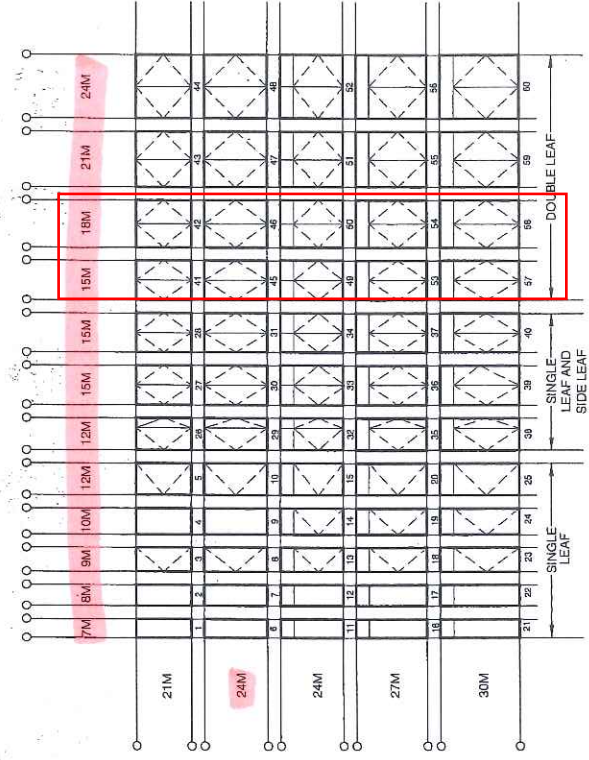


Figure 2. Recommended range of coordinating sizes for doorsets

The range of coordinating sizes for external and internal doorsets is as shown in Figure 2.
